This hands-on training course will provide participants with a comprehensive overview of continental scientific drilling — from project planning and drilling technology to on-site operations and data management. The course is particularly recommended for early-career researchers, including Master’s students, doctoral candidates, and postdoctoral scientists engaged in the preparation or execution of scientific drilling projects.

- **Notification:** Admission decisions will be communicated shortly after a brief review process.
- **Eligibility and selection:** Preference will be given to applicants who are:
 - Involved in ICDP-related drilling projects
 - Affiliated with institutions in ICDP member countries or developing nations
 - Based in countries considering ICDP membership

For selected participants, ICDP will cover travel, visa, accommodation, and meal expenses.
